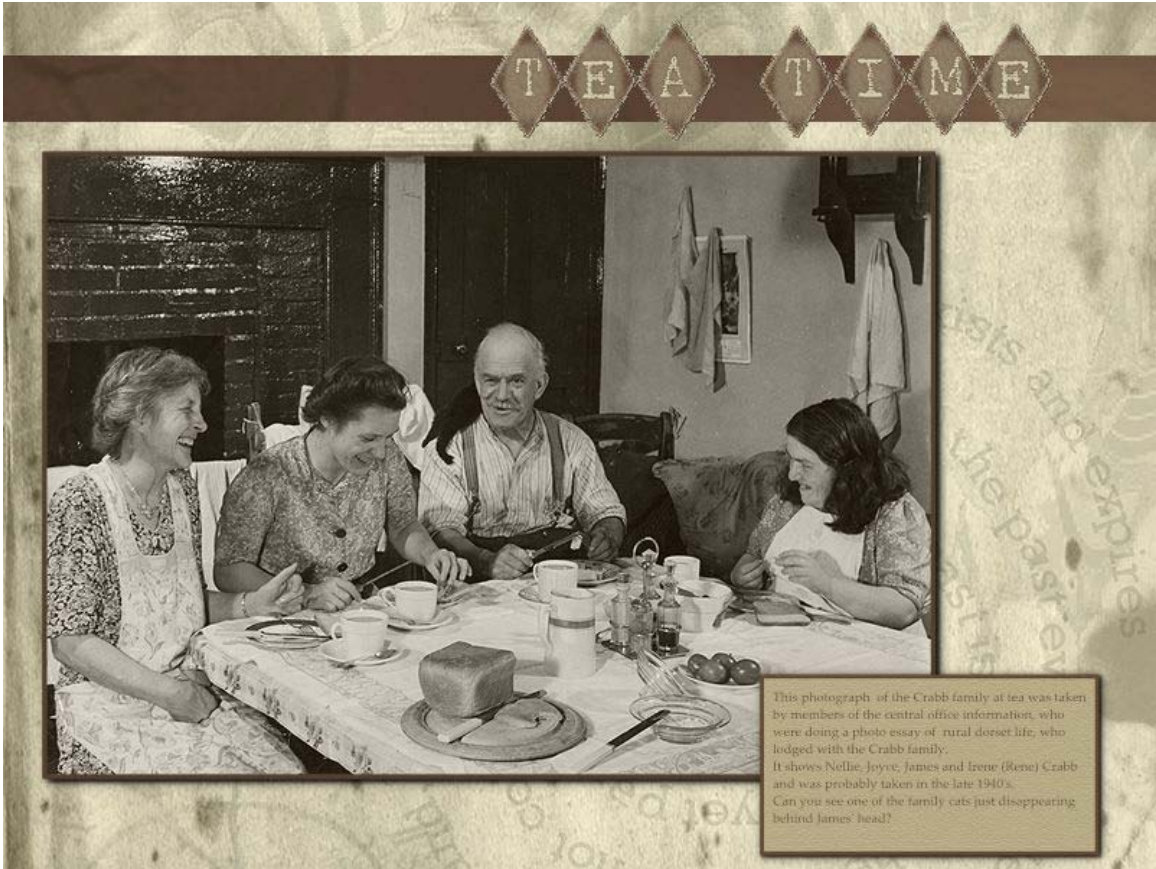

JAMES



James CRABB, son of Isaac CRABB (1844-1924) and Mary Ann SCADDEN (1845-bef1914), was born on 11 April 1883 in Loscombe, Netherbury, Dorset, England. He appeared in the census in 1891 in Wraxall. He appeared in the census in 1901 in Littlebredy and was a Farm Labourer. About 1910, James, along with his Father Isaac and brother George took up the South View Farm in Sydling St Nicholas. He married Nellie RECORD on 5 August 1918 in Rampisham. Between 1918 and 1950 he was a Farmer, Carrier and Coal Merchant, starting with a horse and cart, and progressing to a succession of buses, despite running the buses, James never learned to drive leaving Albie Lovell to drive the bus. He died in 1950 in Sydling St Nicholas and was buried in St. Nicholas Churchyard.




N E L L I E



Nellie RECORD, daughter of Henry RECORD (1864-1935?) and Ellen GOODING (1868-1946), was born on 15 November 1895 in Melbury Sampford, Dorset, England. In 1901 she was living with her family in Rampisham. She married James CRABB on 5 August 1918 in Rampisham Church. Moving to South View Farm in Sydling St Nicholas. She and James had two daughters, Irene (1921-1989) is shown here. Their second daughter Joyce was born in 1929.



When James died in 1950, she lost the tenancy of the farm and she and her daughters and son in Law, Alan Mullins moved to Hit or Miss house. She died on 11 February 1962 in Sydling St Nicholas and was buried in the church yard of Sydling St. Nicholas Church.
