

# Valentine's Day 2009 | Breakfast in Bed Checklist



**TRAY:** A breakfast tray is best. Use a basket or shallow napkin-lined box in a pinch.



**FLOWER:** Use a small vase, a drinking glass, or lay a flower directly on the tray.



**CLOTH NAPKIN:** Find a large cloth napkin to keep the crumbs out of the bed - after this royal treatment you may be using it soon!



**ORANGE JUICE:** Serving juice in a wine glass makes it special.



**COFFEE:** Include milk and sugar on the tray if you're unsure of how they like it.
